## 0. How to Use This Series of Bible Studies

Welcome to Journey With Jesus, a complete set of Bible studies that you can give to help people to know Jesus and Bible prophecy more deeply. This series will help you feel more confident as you share the truth of God's word. You will see that each study is informational, spiritual, and user friendly. The studies are easily accessed as they are meant to be downloaded onto your computer, tablet, or smart phone in PDF format. Here's a few pointers on how to use this series.

Q: Who can I give this series to?

A: Anyone who will sit down and listen to you: friends, family or enemies.

Q: How long should it take to go through this series?

A: There are 29 lessons, so if you do one Bible study a week without interruption, it will take you 6 months and 3 weeks.

Q: Do I need to go through this series in the order provided?

A: It is highly recommended.

Q: Do I need to do every Bible study in the series with them?

A: No, it might be good to give them studies to do on their own that are self-explanatory, but are not extremely important lessons such as: The End of the World, The Imposter, or The Seven Last Plagues.

Q: Do I need to look up every verse in each lesson?

A: No you don't. It is a great idea to read through the lesson before you study with your student. You can skip minor points and then have them look them up on their own. However, it might be good to summarize the verses you skip.

Q: How long should each study take?

A: It will vary depending on how well you know your study and how inquisitive your student is. Generally, you should aim for 45 min, but sometimes it is not possible. Try to keep studies less than 1.5 hours.

Q: How do I go through a lesson?

A: Read the beginning paragraph, ask the question, look up the answer, have them write the answers on the line, and read the note. The answer to each question is always in the note. If there is no note then the answer is obvious. It's also a good idea to tell stories of you own during the lesson to bring each lesson to life.

Q: How do I give an appeal?

A: At the end of each lesson there is provided for you a simple appeal question called: MY CHOICE. Ask the question and have them check the box to chronicle their response.

Q: What are the supplements?

A: The supplements are additional information usually dealing with popularly misunderstood subjects such the Rich Man and Lazarus. The format of each supplement varies and is meant to be printed in portrait format and 8.5 x 11 paper.

Q: How do I print each lesson in front and back? All lessons are designed to be printed in color and on one 8.5 x 11 piece of paper, front and back in landscape format. Manipulate your computer and printer until you can print each lesson on front and back on one page.
